Dr. Shane D. Courtland received a Ph.D. in Philosophy from Tulane University and is currently employed as the Managing Director of Academic Relations at the Institute for Humane Studies. Previously, Dr. Courtland served as the Managing Director of the Center for Free Enterprise at West Virginia University.

Dr. Courtland's publications have appeared in American Catholioc Philosophical Quarterly, Pacific Philosophical Quarterly,

Journal of Environmental Philosophy, Journal of Applied Philosophy, Journal of Mind and Behavior, Southwest Philosophy Review, Hobbes Studies, Reason Papers, Utilitas, Stanford Encyclopedia of Philosophy, Routledge's The Value and Limits of Academic Speech: Philosophical, Political, and Legal Perspectives, Routledge's American Philosophy: an Encyclopedia, Routledge's Political Ethics, Wiley-Blackwell's The Ultimate South Park and Philosophy Book, and Wiley-Blackwell's House of Cards and Philosophy. He also published an edited volume, Hobbesian Applied Ethics and Public Policy (Routledge 2017). n the now classic Kindly Inquisitors, Jonathan Rauch writes, "It is not good to offend people, but it is necessary. A no offense society is a no knowledge society" (Rauch 1993, 126). Often when educators try to shield students from offensive views they compromise the attainment of knowledge. In this presentation Dr. Shane Courland will examine one version of this problem. Namely, whether or not it is appropriate to silence such views because they call into question the dignity of marginalized groups.


With the assistance of principles laid down by John Stuart Mill, Dr. Courtland argues that it is epistemically problematic to silence the expression of these views. To know something requires that one be familiar with, and perhaps even seriously entertain, falsehoods. The failure to do so, would deny one knowledge, even including knowledge of the views one currently endorses (via a Millian dead dogma). Moreover, the elimination of racist viewpoints would also have the unintended consequence of undermining marginalized groups' (or their advocates') ability to disarm bigoted arguments.
