

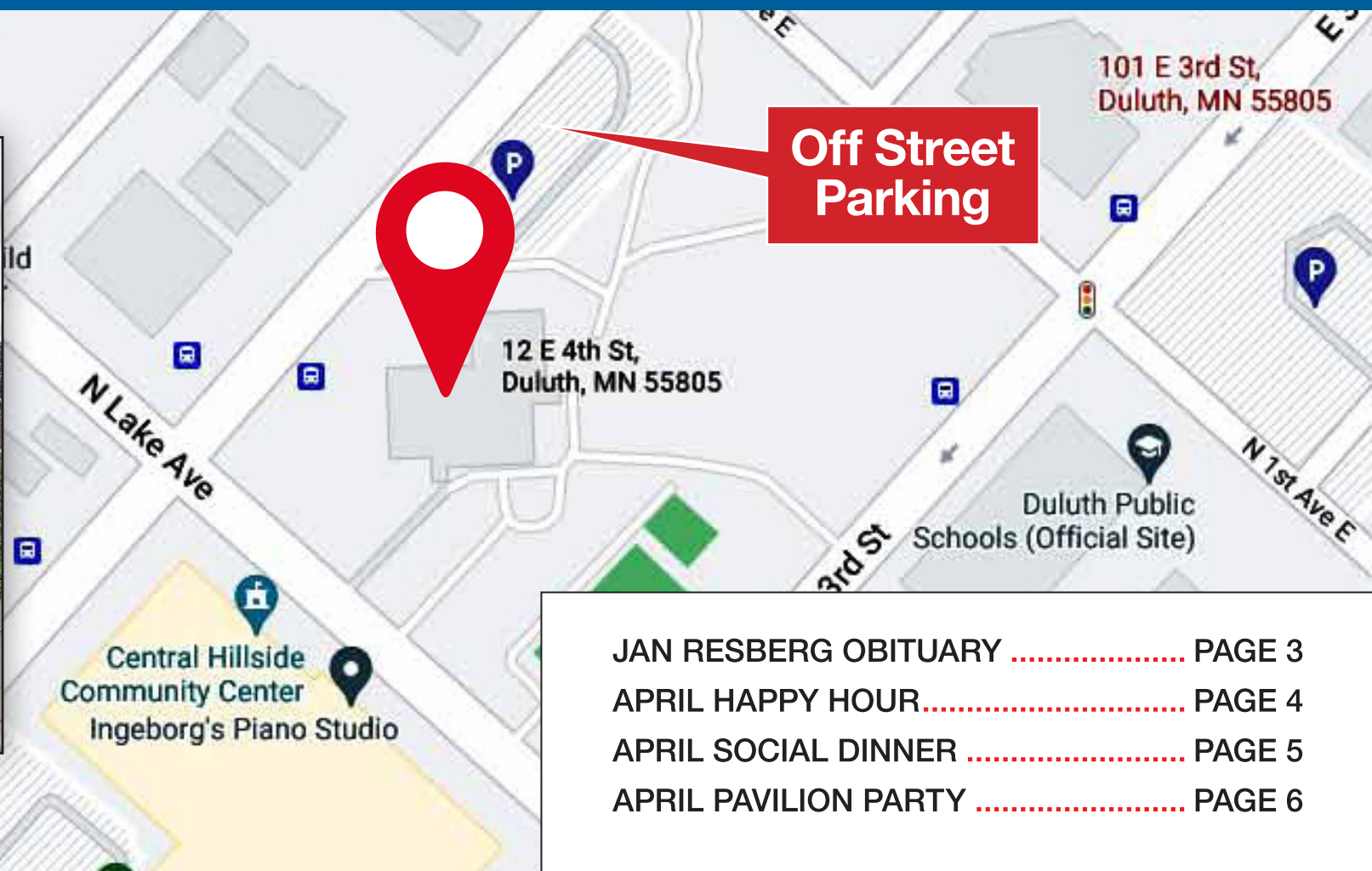

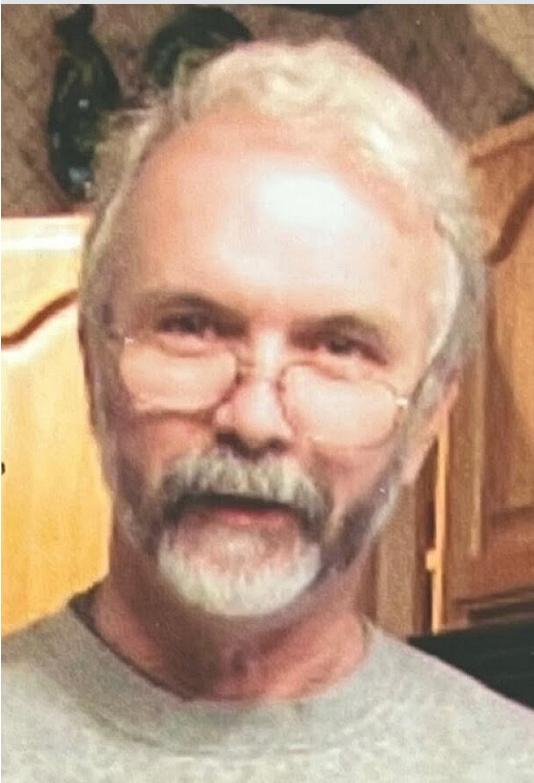

Former LSF Chairman Jan Resberg passed away on March 11th, 2023. Below is his self-written obituary.



Jan Marc Resberg of Superior, Wisconsin was born in Duluth, Minnesota on December 9, 1947 to Alvin and Irene (Patnaude) Resberg. He passed away on March 11, 2023 of pancreatic cancer.
